
Summary of previous sessions

- Some of the issues from Vision, Principles, Stewardship, Character and Identity: -
 - The site should consider its relationship to areas both north and south, but gap between PR6a and Kidlington important
 - The relationship with the Oxford city site on the south-west boundary needs to be carefully considered
 - Green spaces and open spaces should be created for all kinds of people, in the extension to Cutteslowe Park and into the scheme
 - Views out to the countryside are important
 - Links to, and through, Cutteslowe Park are very important
 - The park at Barton Park is great
 - The dark bricks at Barton Park are not representative of local styles, and not well-loved
 - There are good opportunities to create a strong community through the interrelationship between the local centre, community buildings, and the school

- Inter-relationships between uses are important













- Location of school impacts walkable 'catchment'
- Consider 'walkable' routes to school
- Important community and physical synergy between school and local centre
- Local Plan arrangement
 - No synergy between school and local centre
 - School 'catchment' poor






- Option from Development Brief
- Works with entrance from P&R
- Not central to PR6a and PR6b
- Close to P&R / rail station





- Option from Development Brief
- Local centre can draw on Oxford Rd
- Local centre protects school from road noise
- Good access from existing footpath and bridleway routes





- Option from Development Brief
- School feathers into countryside
- Good access from existing footpath and bridleway routes
- Local centre can draw on Oxford Rd





- Location of school impacts walkable 'catchment'
